Information clause for Fellowship Holder

According to Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (EU Official Journal L 119 of 4 May 2016) - hereinafter referred to as GDPR - and Article 14(1) and (2) of the GDPR, we inform you that:

- 3. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of implementing the scholarship program, including payment of the scholarship and tax and accounting regulations (in accordance with Article 6(1)(b) and (c) of the GDPR).
- 4. Your data will be kept indefinitely after the provision of services, to the extent required by applicable law.
- 5. Recipients of your personal data will be entities authorized to do so under applicable law.
- 6. You have the right to request access to your personal data and their rectification. You also have the right to request erasure or restriction of processing, data portability, and the right to object to processing, but only if further processing is not necessary for the controller to fulfill its legal obligation or if there are no overriding legal grounds for processing.
- 7. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office regarding the processing of your personal data by the controller (uodo.gov.pl).
- 8. Providing your data is voluntary but necessary for evaluating the implementation of the Thesaurus Poloniae scholarship agreement. Failure to provide required information or providing incomplete information will make it impossible to pay the scholarship.
